



2010 Ethics Training Registration Form

The NCACC and the N.C. League of Municipalities, in conjunction with the School of Government at the University of North Carolina-Chapel Hill, have scheduled six regional training sessions in April to enable local government elected officials to obtain the ethics education requirements contained in S.L. 2009-403 (Local Government Code of Ethics). This new law, passed last year by the General Assembly, requires “all members of governing boards of cities, counties, local boards of education, unified governments, sanitary districts, and consolidated city-counties shall receive a minimum of two clock hours of ethics education” during the calendar year 2010.

The NCACC will be hosting three of the training sessions, and the NCLM will host three. City and county officials are eligible to attend either session to receive the training.
