# **Items of Business**

There were only two items of business on the agenda that required action. First was an increase in the membership dues to cover credit card transaction fees. The membership period will occur before the Association meets again. The second item was the approval of the slate of officers. This item was required so the new officers could assume their responsibilities and serve a full term. Since the members were participating remotely, the vote was made by unanimous consent. Objections would be dealt with accordingly, if any.

#### Membership Dues for 2020-21

Treasurer Debbie Harris presented this item for approval. At the November Business Meeting it was announced that a request to increase the membership fee was forthcoming. Due to our new partnership with the NCACC, we are now able to use their portal for online registrations. The credit card companies charge a percentage of the transaction in fees. The Association cannot absorb those costs, so it was determined that the appropriate action was to increase the membership from \$50 to \$55 beginning with the FY 2020-21 membership year. Membership fees with be due during the first quarter of the fiscal year – July 1- September 30.

Julie Bennett moved to approve the increase in the membership fee from \$50 to \$55, seconded by Lindsay Ray. The motion was approved by unanimous consent and without any objection.
