<p>Legislative Land Use <i>(examples: rezoning or text amendment)</i> GS 153A-340(g); 160A-381(d)</p>	<p>Direct, substantial, and readily identifiable financial interest in the matter</p>	<p>Cannot participate or vote</p>
<p>Quasi-Judicial Hearing <i>(examples: special use permit or appeal of a personnel decision)</i> GS 153A-345.1; GS 160A-388(e)(2)</p>	<p>Fixed opinion prior to the hearing, undisclosed ex parte communications, close familial, business, or other relationship with an affected person, or financial interest in outcome</p>	<p>Cannot participate or vote</p>
<p>Contract GS 14-234</p>	<p>Prohibited direct benefit that would be derived by you or your spouse under the contract <i>and</i> the contract is allowed under an exception</p>	<p>Cannot participate or vote</p>
<p>All Other Matters GS 153A-44; GS 160A-75</p>	<p>Financial interest in the matter or the matter involves your own official conduct</p>	<p>May be excused from voting</p>
