What is NCACC's Strategic Member Services?

NCACC is building internal capacity and expertise to help counties respond to the heightened load of American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) and national opioid settlement administrative duties through a new service arm, Strategic Member Services (SMS).

SMS will strive to assist counties in the areas of:

Strategic planning and collaborative conversations

NCACC Outreach Associates, a specialized team of professionals with county management or finance experience will facilitate discussions with county staff and boards of county commissioners to set direction and goals for county services.

Federal compliance standards and eligible projects

NCACC staff with targeted knowledge of federal Uniform Guidance provisions will provide expertise and guidance to counties in multiple areas, including Cost Principles and Single Audit Act requirements, and help meet the requirements of the opioid settlement MOA.

Project management, grant management, subrecipient monitoring and oversight, expenditure reporting, community outreach, and communications

Operating at the heart of Strategic Member Services is a cohort of Strategic Project Coordinators. Master's level graduates in the fields of public administration (or affairs), finance, public health, and/or accounting are being recruited for positions with NCACC to help counties meet the requirements associated with ARPA or opioid settlement funding related projects.

The Strategic Project Coordinators, with the support of the NCACC team, will enjoy the benefit of sharing experiences and lessons through peer-based learning and professional development programs developed by the Association.

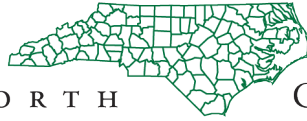
The Association Policy Team offers presentations and issue analysis on the economy, taxes, budgeting, local government legal issues, and specific policy issues.
