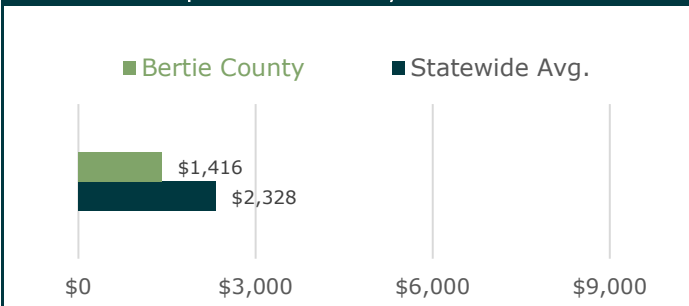
38% of residents are covered by Medicaid.(4)	13% of residents under 65 are uninsured.(2)	17% of households are food insecure.(3)

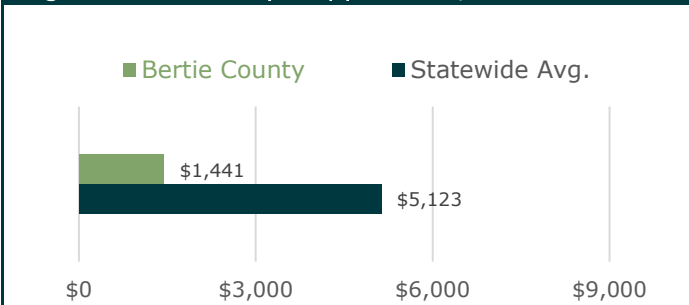
Education
