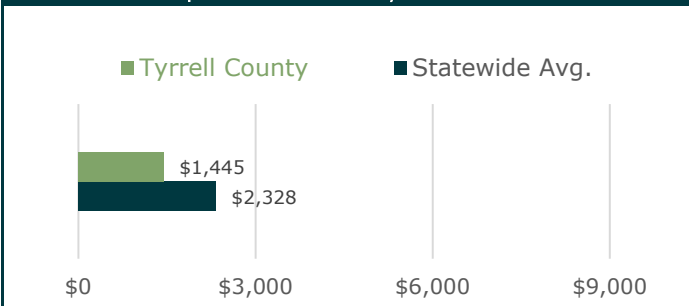

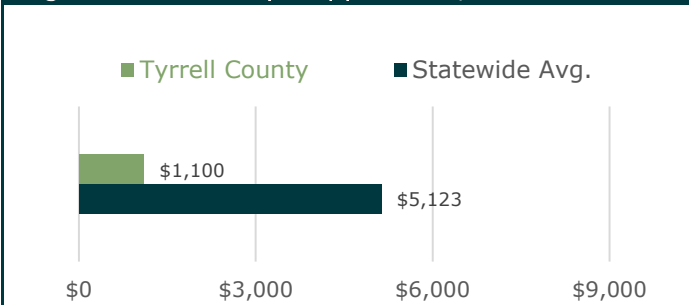
Education
