

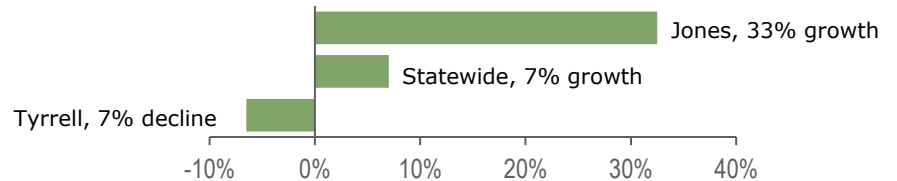
North Carolina Counties: Gross Domestic Product (GDP), 2021

County GDP is the local equivalent of the national GDP. It measures the value of goods and services produced in a county -- in essence, GDP is a measure of the size of an economy.

97

97 North Carolina counties saw GDP growth in 2021.

Across the counties, the change in GDP ranged from -7% to +33% in 2021, after adjusting for inflation.
