Broadband Internet Access

This table shows the percentage of fully served Broadband Serviceable Locations (BSLs) in each county as of June 2023. A BSL is a business or residential location at which fixed broadband internet is or can be installed.

Access to internet is determined based on the broadband speeds experienced at a location; speeds are measured for both upload and download, which are the speeds at which information can be sent to and received from the device to the internet. A BSL is considered "fully served" if it has a minimum download speed of 100 Mbps and a minimum upload speed of at least 20 Mbps (referred to as 100/20 Mbps), as outlined by the Federal Communications Commission. This definition aligns with the requirements set by ongoing federal and state broadband expansion programs, which require Internet Service Providers to commit to providing internet speeds of at least 100/20 Mbps.
