
Introduction WHAT IS THE LOCAL ELECTED LEADERS ACADEMY?





LELA Credentials Online System SYSTEM OVERVIEW

- Digital badges awarded for educational opportunities (SOG courses) and service opportunities through NCACC
- Learning pathways that allow you to track your progress
- Badges and pathways that clearly reflect the four recognition levels



LELA Credentials Online System



- A digital badge is a credential awarded online that verifies a skill or achievement
- It contains metadata that verifies the awardee, date of award, and achievement recognized
- Badges can be shared via social media or web pages or transferred to other digital badging systems




