

North Carolina Counties: American Indian Population

Did you know that every North Carolina county is home to residents who identify as American Indian? To honor the contributions, achievements, sacrifices, and cultural and historical legacy of the original inhabitants of what is now the United States, November has been proclaimed <u>American Indian Heritage Month</u>.

All 100 counties are home to residents who identify as American Indian. 77% of counties have more American Indian residents than a decade ago. 35% of North Carolina's American Indian residents live in Robeson County.
