

North Carolina Counties:

Per Capita Income in 2022

Per capita income is one measure of economic well-being. In 2022, Anson County's 6% growth was the highest statewide, but even this growth did not keep pace with inflation, which measured 6.5% nationally from December 2021 to December 2022, according to the <u>Bureau of Labor Statistics' Consumer Price Index</u>.

8 78 counties saw per capita income increase in 2022.



22 counties saw per capita income decrease in 2022.



43 counties exceeded the national personal income growth rate of 1.6% for 2022.
