


North Carolina Counties: 2023 Population

Since the 2020 Census, North Carolina's population has grown by an estimated 382,000 residents, bringing the state's population to an estimated 10.8 million.

83 of the state's 100 counties have grown since the 2020 Census.



The fastest growth rate since 2020 was in Brunswick County; the sharpest rate of decline was in Hertford County. 5 counties grew over 10% since 2020: Brunswick, Currituck, Franklin, Johnston, and Pender.
